REGULATIONS

I, Enoch Godongwana, Member of the Executive Council responsible for Economic Affairs in the Province of the Eastern Cape, acting in terms of section 14 (6) of the Consumer Affairs (Unfair Business Practices) Act, 1998 (Act No. 5 of 1998) hereby make the regulations with regard to the procedure for the conduct of interviews of candidates for appointment to the Eastern Consumer Tribunal as set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

1. Composition of Panel.—Panel must be appointed by the MEC and must be composed of the following:

- (a) one person admitted as an Advocate;
- (b) one person having special knowledge or experience of Economics, Industry or Commerce or someone from Non-Governmental Organisations;
- (c) two representatives from the Department of Economic Affairs, Environment and Tourism; and
- (d) a representative from organized labour.

2. Procedure for Interviews.—The interviews must be held in the office of the Member of the Executive Council responsible for Economic Affairs, or at another venue as may be determined by him or her and will be open to the public.

3. The interviews must be chaired by one of the members of the panel designated by the MEC.

4. The interviews must be conducted in a fair and unbiased manner and all the candidates must be afforded equal opportunity.

5. The proceedings must be recorded.
